

“The Meeting for the Evaluation of the Turkish Overseas Contracting and Engineering Consultancy Services Sector” took place in Ankara. The meeting was followed by an Award Ceremony, where 38 Turkish contractors in the ENR 250 list, were presented awards by the Ministry of Economy. Chairman of the Board and CEO Emin Sazak received the award on behalf of Yüksel İnşaat.

Bringing the most renowned representatives of the Turkish contracting sector together, “The Overseas Contracting and Technical Consulting Sector’s Assessment Meeting and Award Ceremony” was held in Ankara with participation of Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdoğan and Zafer Çağlayan, Minister of Economy. Prime Minister Erdoğan gave a speech at the event and thanked contractors for improving the reputation of the country worldwide and for expanding the Turkish economy. After reminding that like in previous years Turkey once more ranked second following China in the ENR 250 list with 38 companies, Erdoğan expressed his contentment.

Economy Minister Zafer Çağlayan drew attention towards the recent fast development of the Turkish contracting sector and noted that the sector is expected to bring in USD 100 million annually in the frame of the 2023 vision of the government. Following the speeches, Prime Minister Erdoğan presented awards to the representatives of the 38 contracting and 4 engineering consultancy companies that entered the ENR 2013, the list showing the 250 largest construction companies of the world. Yüksel İnşaat, which ranked 9th in Turkey and 124th in the world list, was among the award winners. On behalf of Yüksel İnşaat, Chairman of the Board and CEO Emin Sazak received the award from Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdoğan.
